

2010 EVRGC Rules & Regulations

NOTICES:

WAIVER & RELEASE: YOU MUST SIGN A WAIVER AND RELEASE TO USE THE PARK. *

- The shooting park is open to members of the Eagle Valley Rod and Gun Club (a.k.a the Gypsum Gun Club) and to the public from 8 AM to dusk daily, except as otherwise allowed by the Club's Board, indicated below and on the Club Calendar. Except as indicated below, public non-member use is limited to only pedestrian access through the portal adjacent to and north of the main vehicle gate.
- It shall be unlawful for any person to use the park after-hours or to use the park without signing a Waiver and Release.

Waiver and Release forms are part of the New Member and Member Renewal Applications. Non-member Waiver and Release forms will be provided by coordinators of any shooting event to both spectators and participants. Other non-members must complete, sign and deposit a Waiver and Release at the station located at the Rifle Range.

ANY PERSON VIOLATING THESE WAIVER AND RELEASE RULES WILL BE CONSIDERED A TRESPASSER AND MAY BE PROSECUTED TO THE FULLEST EXTENT OF THE LAW.

*You need only sign one waiver per calendar year.

Membership Privileges: As provided for by ARTICLE V, **MEMBERSHIP**, of the Bylaws: "Membership shall be terminated after a reasonably prompt hearing before and by a majority vote of the Board of Directors for, but not limited to, failure to annually pay required fees and bonds and failure to comply with Club Rules and Regulations. Board Members, the Caretaker(s) and others specifically designated by the Board may immediately suspend membership and eject a member from the premises for failure to comply with the Rules and Regulations. "

Persons under the age of 21 may not possess or shoot any pistol unless under the supervision of their parent or legal guardian. Persons under the age of 18 may not possess or shoot any long gun unless under the supervision of their parent or legal guardian.

Safety Rules: All members and guests must abide by the following safety requirements...

1. Assume that all guns are loaded and treat them as so at all times;
2. Keep all guns pointed down range or in a safe direction at all times;
3. Do not load firearms until ready to shoot;
4. Keep your finger off the trigger until you have acquired your target and are willing to shoot said target. If you see a fellow shooter exhibiting unsafe practices, protect yourself and leave the area! If possible locate the caretaker who will call the sheriff. If

necessary call (911) the sheriff yourself, from a safe distance, and report the dangerous actions.

Alcohol & Drugs: Alcohol of any type or form and drugs are not permitted on the premises nor are persons, members of the Club or of the public, who are under the influence of any substance.

Range Fees: All Non-Member shooters must pay the daily range fee.

OPERATIONS:

All Year: Members have vehicular access to all ranges subject to closures, events and Trap availability and other use restrictions. The Club Calendar, at www.gypsumgunclub.com, provides up to date access and use details.

Summer: April 1 – September 30

Daily...In addition to the schedule below, rifle and pistol walk-in public access** is available, 8 AM to dusk, through the man-gate located on the north side of the club road at the Main gate.

Saturdays...10 Am- 2PM Public*** Rifle, Pistol and Trap shooting. ATA competitions are scheduled in advance of the summer season. Check the Club Website Calendar for dates; public and members are excluded from all other shooting during ATA shoots; **Ranges Closed.**

Turkey and Toy Shoots and other special events will be posted on the Club Website Calendar and will **close all or some ranges as posted.**

Single Action Shooting Society (Cowboy Action Shooting) competitions are every second Sunday of the month at 10 AM to 2 PM. If an ATA match is scheduled for one of these Sundays, SASS moves to the preceding Saturday. The **Rifle Range is closed** to all shooters during these shoots.

Tuesday & Wednesdays... 5 PM- Dusk Public*** Rifle, Pistol and Trap Shooting.

Thursdays...4H training and sports take place evenings 6PM – dusk from mid-May to the end of October and all other access and shooting is prohibited; **Ranges Closed to members and the public.**

Volunteer Work Days will be scheduled from time to time on Saturday or Sunday. All or part of the facility may be closed. Check the Club Website Calendar for schedule.

Shooting classes will be scheduled from time to time and will close one or more ranges for part of a day. Check the Club Website for schedule and closures.

Archery: No competitive events are currently held.

Winter: October 1 – March 31 (Weather Permitting)

Daily...In addition to the schedule below, rifle and pistol walk-in public access** is available, 8 AM to dusk, through the man-gate located on the north side of the club road at the Main gate.

Saturdays... 10 AM - 2PM Public*** Rifle and Pistol shooting only. No Trap shooting. Traps open only by special arrangement for scheduled events. Check Club Website Calendar for schedule and **closure of all or some ranges as posted.**

Wednesdays... 8 AM – Dusk Public*** Rifle and Pistol shooting only.

Volunteer Work Days will be scheduled from time to time on Saturday or Sunday. All or part of the facility may be closed. Check the Club Website Calendar for schedule.

Shooting classes will be scheduled from time to time and will close one or more ranges for part of a day. Check the Club Website for schedule and closures.

Hunting Season: October 1 – November 15 (Weather Permitting)

Daily... 8 AM – Dusk Unlimited free public vehicular access to the Rifle and Pistol Ranges for gun sighting.

Non-Member & Guest Fees:

** Man-gate open for walk-in public access: \$5 per person per day non-member Range Fee required for these days and times. Payment is "Honor System" at rifle range drop box.

*** Main Gate open for drive-in public access: \$5 per person per day non-member Range Fee required for these days and times. Pay Caretaker, if present, otherwise use the "Honor System" drop box at the rifle range.
